Minutes of the meeting held at 1200 hrs on 11.11.2024 to discuss the issues related to special guests being invited to witness the Republic day Parade, 2025 at Kartavya Path New Delhi.

A meeting was held at 1200 hours on 11.11.2024 in Room No.203, South Block, New Delhi to discuss the issues with reference to the Special Guests being invited during Republic Day Parade, 2025. The list of participants of the meeting is at **Annexure - II**.

- 2. JS(Ceremonials), Ministry of Defence extended a warm welcome to all the participants thereafter a presentation was made by DS(Ceremonials), Ministry of Defence highlighting the tentative categories of Special Guests and actions to be taken by various stakeholders involved in making arrangements related to Special Guests which are as under:-
 - (a) For the Republic Day Parade 2025, focus is to invite such Individuals/SHGs/Volunteers etc. who are contributing towards growth of society in any field like employment generation; sustainability; environment protection. Beneficiaries of various government schemes and volunteers who are helping at grassroot level are also being considered as a token of appreciation for their efforts.
 - (b) The proposed list as decided in the meeting is enclosed.
 - (c) Ministries/Departments will confirm the tentative list of categories and share the selection criteria of Special Guests to this Ministry by 17th November, 2024.
 - (d) Ministries/Departments would nominate/depute Nodal Officer(s) for Special Guests who would be contacted by Ministry of Defence for further liaison.
 - (e) The nodal officer(s) nominated/deputed by the Ministries/Departments will provide the list(s) of Special Guests to Ministry of Defence for issuing Invitation Cards. If Nodal Officer from any Ministry/Department has not been deputed/nominated yet, the officer present in the meeting would be considered as Nodal Officer and further communication would be made with them as and when required. Format in which data is to be provided is enclosed as Annexure-III.
 - (f) List of Special Guests (in searchable pdf format as well as excel/word format) to be provided to Ministry of Defence in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-III) as soon as possible but in any case not later than 10.12.2024. List of guests should be segregated state wise for verification by security agencies.
 - (g) Keeping in view of security vetting of Special Guests by Delhi Police(Sec/PM) and preparation of seating related arrangements, Ministry of Defence will not be in a position to entertain any request of addition/deletion/modification in the guest list after 10.12.2024.
 - (h) For each 20 Guest, one Liaison Officer to be deputed from the Ministry/Department or from State/UT. The Liaison Officers will also be provided Invitation Cards and will be seated in the Special Guests Enclosure.



- (i) The Invitation cards of these Guests will be provided/handed over to the Nodal Officer(s). The Nodal Officer(s) will further distribute the Invitation Cards to the concerned Special Guest.
- (j) On receipt of adverse comments, if any, for Special Guest(s) from Security agencies, the nodal officers would immediately withdraw the invitation card and will return the same to D(Ceremonials), MoD.
- (k) All Special Guests/Liaison Officers/Nodal Officers to use the services of Delhi Metro for reaching their designated seating enclosure at Kartavya Path on 26.01.2025. Adjoining Metro Stations Central Secretariat and Udyog Bhawan will remain open on this day. A certain point/location may be decided by each Ministry/Department from where the special Guests take Metro Services for the Parade.
- (I) Due to scarcity of parking space, no buses will be used to carry Special Guests on 26.01.2025.
- (m) All Nodal Officers have to take part in all the rehearsals of Republic Day Parade at Kartavya Path.
- (n) DCP(Sec/PM) will issue Photo Duty Badges to all the Nodal Officers for their entry at designated seating enclosures during the Parade. DCP(Sec/PM) will also deploy one officer to facilitate the Nodal Officers in preparing their Photo Duty Badges.
- (o) All Nodal Officers would visit the O/o DCP(Sec/PM), Manas Marg, Bapu Dham, New Delhi to get themselves photographed for issuing Photo Duty Badges.
- (p) All Nodal Officers have also to conduct a Route rehearsal by Metro.
- (q) Dir(EMR), DGHS would make necessary arrangements to provide emergency medical assistance to Special Guests, if required and would sensitize the medical authorities about movement and stay of Special Guests to ensure medical facility on priority basis.
- (r) DMRC will issue Metro ride coupons for Special Guests.
- (s) Since, the number of Special Guests are too Ministry/Department/Organisation may plan the date and place of site visit of Special Guests according to the convenience of Ministry/Department/Organization concerned. The Ministry/Department/Organisation would share the information like Number of Special Guests; Date & time of their arrival; their Stay Points/Station at Delhi/NCR; their visit plan/Local site seeing plan; Date & time of departure of Special Guests; schedule of high tea/lunch/dinner to be hosted for Special Guests with respective Cabinet Minister/Minister of State to Ministry of Defence and DCP(Traffic) of concerned areas where site visit plan is being scheduled to manage smooth movement of Buses carrying the Special Guests and to ensure their security arrangements.
- (t) All arrangements of the Special Guests are to be made by the concerned Ministry/Department/Organizations from their own budget.

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- (u) The Check-list, enclosed at **Annexure-IV**, for seamless conduct of various activities related to Special Guests is to be followed up by the Nodal Officer(s).
- 3. After the presentation, the participants were welcomed to flag their issue if any, as well as their suggestions on the subject matter. The issues/suggestions of the participants were discussed and following actions were decided to be undertaken:-
 - (a) The Ministry/Department/Organization may conduct the security vetting/antecedent verification of Special Guests at their own level through concerned State/UT Police authorities. This will be in addition to the security vetting to be conducted by Security Wing of Delhi Police.
 - (b) Concerned authority of NWM, PM Sangrahalaya and Parliament House etc. may be contacted by the Nodal Officers to schedule the local visit/site seeing plan of Special Guests at NWM, PM Sangrahalaya and Parliament House etc.
 - (c) PM Sangrahalaya may waive off the entry fee etc. for Special Guests.
 - (d) Ministry/Department/Organization are advised not to invite children/family member with Special Guest. As far as possible the Guests may be accompanied with their spouse. In case of students/youths etc. they may accompanied with their parent/teacher/guardian.
 - (e) To witness the Republic Day Ceremony, Special Guests must bring any valid identity card (Aadhar/PAN/Voter Card etc.) with them in addition to the Invitation Cards of the Ceremony.
 - (f) The Special Guests should reach their designated enclosure by 06:00 AM. For the purpose, Delhi Police to deploy one local police officer (well conversant of the route of the Kartavya Path from staying point of Special Guests) with Nodal Officers. The deputed police officer should be briefed properly about his duties as these Guests are specially invited by the Government of India from across the country.
