**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Submission of Feedback on iGOT Karmayogi Platform Courses for interaction with Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti –reg.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the OM dated 26.06.2025, issued by the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), concerning the implementation of point no. 11 from the Minutes of the review meeting chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 31.01.2024. The meeting reviewed the progress made during the FY 2023-24 in the Road Transport and Highways sector.

2. The following action point also emerged during the review meeting:
