6. The officers shall submit a report about their visit to the Ministry of External Affairs (East Asia Division) and Department of Water Resources, RD & GR (EA&IC Division) within one month of their return to India.
7. The visit is being treated as personal visit as per DoE guidelines vide OM No.4(4)/E.Coordl2015 dated 5th Jan 2016. Therefore, the officers will **take leave** for the period of the visit.
