ORDER

Subject: Deputation abroad of Shri Deepak Kumar to Netherlands for training during 29th March to 15th April, 2016.

Sanction of the Competent Authority is hereby accorded to the deputation of Shri Deepak Kumar, Sr. Joint Commissioner (NHP), MoWR, RD&GR to attend short term training course on Hydrological Data Collection and Processing at UNESCO-IHE, Delft, Netherlands during 29th March to 15th April, 2016 (excluding travel time):-

- 2. The above-mentioned officials are sanctioned the following:
- (i) Air passage: As per entitlement.
- (ii) Course fee (tuition fee + study related costs + insurance): Euro 2560.25/- to be paid directly to UNESCO-IHE.
- (iii) Hotel Accommodation: \$ 3000 (@ \$150 per night, for 20 days) to be arranged by Indian Mission in Netherlands
- (iv) Daily allowance: US\$1875 (@ US\$ 100 per day for initial 15 days and US\$ 75 per day for subsequent 5 days) to be released by Indian Mission in the Netherlands
- (v) Conveyance: To be provided by Indian Mission in the Netherlands from the Schiphol to Delft and back to Schiphol and internal travel in Netherlands may be reimbursed if not arranged by the Indian Mission.
- 3. The expenditure at para 2(ii) above will be charged to OAE head of NHP 2701.80.004.08.02.20 for 2015-16 in respect of the above official. Expenses on other items other than para 2(ii) above may be charged to head: 3451.00.090.16.01.12—Secretariat Economic Services—Secretariat-Ministry of Water Resources-Foreign Travel Expenses of the Ministry of Water Resources, RD&GR for the year 2015-16.
- 4. The period of absence from the post in India and grant of pay and allowances and counting of increment for the above mentioned official will be regulated in accordance with the provisions of Para 13-15 of the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure O. M. No. 19036/7/75-E.IV (B) dated 5.8.1976.
- 5. The resignation or request for voluntary retirement from service while abroad will not be entertained under any circumstances. The official will not stay abroad under any circumstances beyond the approved period without the prior sanction of Government of India.
