The fourth Quarterly Review Meeting was held on 20.10.2016 under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister (WR, RD&GR) in the CWC Auditorium, R.K. Puram, New Delhi where both the Hon'ble Minister of State(WR, RD&GR) were also present. Progress of decisions of last Quarterly Review Meeting, action plan for 2016-17, New Initiatives Undertaken, Budget Utilization & Action Plan for next 6 months were reviewed and deliberated in detail.

2. At the outset, JS(A) welcomed all the members of the Meeting and mentioned that under present government, Ministry of Water Resources, RD & GR has taken a number of initiatives for effective management of water resources through implementation of various schemes. With a aim to review the activities undertaken by the different Wings and Organizations under MoWR, RD&GR, quarterly follow up meetings were initiated in June, 2015 under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister (WR, RD & GR). This is the fourth meeting in this series. He emphasized that during the presentation the focus should be on clearly verifiable indicators.
