Subject: Enabling Non-automated/ Semi-automated Departments to Make Electronic Payments Receipts.

In the meeting of the Apex Committee on Digital India held on 15th October, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary, it was decided that all Government payments & receipts should be online urgently. A copy of the minutes is enclosed. It is seen that many of the Government payments & receipts are still transacted physically through cash/demand draft/cheque. These payments now need to be made electronically.

- As many of the Departments still do not have an automated backend system where payments can be collected electronically by the Department, DeitY has created a centralized National Generic Payment Portal (NGPP) that would be available at https://www.PayOnline.gov.in, which will enable citizen/consumer to make online payments for availing the Government services. NGPP has been developed for both web and mobile apps and hosted in NIC Cloud as a centralized model for the all Gol applications/States/UTs.
- The NGPP aims to provide a single unified portal for various Departments which do not have any applications to receive online payments from the consumers. The NGPP shall be implemented as follows:
  - a. Departments with non-automated backend: Manual challan system currently available would be implemented electronically. The payment would be transferred & reported to the State/Department treasury through the existing Banking system. Consumers would be able to take a print of the challan created online and submit the same to the Department as
  - b. Departments with semi-automated backend: NGPP shall be integrated with the Department's semi-automated backend system in order to update
- It is therefore requested that all the Central/State/UT Departments/Public sector undertakings, State Corporations, Municipal Corporations, Government Bodies and Public utilities, to immediately identify physical payments/receipts (cash/cheque) within their organization and use this Portal to make these payments
