
**Subject:- All government payment and receipts to be made online.**

I am directed to bring to your kind notice to the meeting of the Apex Committee on Digital India held on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary. It was decided that all Government payments & receipts should be online urgently.

It is seen that many of the Government payments & receipts are still transacted physically through cash/demand draft/cheque and now need to be made electronically. In this regard, DeitY has prepared a "Framework for Adoption of Electronic Payments and Receipts by Departments and Institutions" which aims to harness the potential of electronic cashless payments platforms for various Payments or Receipts handled by Departments/Institutions. This framework aims to white list Payment Service Providers and also provides a basic platform for automation of simple payments requiring no back end infrastructure.

The main objective of this framework is:

- To categorization services offered by Departments on basis of IT enablement and readiness with respect to payment integration
- To provide guidelines and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) according to levels and types of services.
- To provide information on engagement with various payment service providers.
- To provide implementation methodology

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly provide your valuable comments on the framework latest by 18<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2015.
