Sir,

I am to inform that the implementation of e-Procurement was reviewed in the 20th Review Meeting on e-Governance taken by JS (A) on 11.12.2015 and the progress in implementation of e-Procurement has not been found to be satisfactory in your Organization. This is being reviewed in e-Governance review Meetings taken by JS (A), regularly.

2. As per the Department of Expenditure's guidelines, all Ministries / Departments of the Central Government and their Attached/ Subordinate Offices are required to commence e-Procurement in respect of all procurements made with minimum tender value of Rs. 10.00 Lakhs w.e.f. 01.04.2014; which was to be brought down to Rs. 5.00 Lakhs w.e.f. 01.04.2015, and further down to Rs. 02.00 Lakhs w.e.f. 01.04.2016.

3. In view of the above, it is requested that the necessary action for implementation of e-Procurement may please be expedited so as to ensure its implementation by 01.01.2016 and an action taken report may be furnished to the undersigned latest by 30.12.2015 positively.
