

Minutes of 115th Weekly Review Meeting held under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister (WR, RD & GR) on 26.04.2017

The 115th Weekly Review Meeting was held on 26.04.2017 under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister(WR, RD & GR) in which progress of continuation of different Schemes beyond 12th Plan, status of EFC/SFC proposal of Schemes, presentation of Integrated Flood Management Programme, Progress of work of DEM and Parliamentary Assurances/PMO references/VIP references/Court Cases and Contempt cases/Vigilance cases/Grievance cases were discussed in detail. The following action points were identified for further action:

- The concerned officers of following continuing schemes costing more than Rs. 500 Crores need to submit the EFC proposals to JS & FA immediately for sending to Ministry of Finance.
 - (a)DRIP
 - (b)River Basin Management.
 - (c) DWRIS
 - (d)Ground Water Management.
 - (e) FMP
 - (f) River Management Activity in Border Areas.
 - (g)Infrastructure Development - After adding the proposal of proposed Jal Bhavan.

- Third Party Evaluation of each Scheme shall

be done on priority and shall be incorporated in the EFC/SFC proposal of the Scheme.

- NBCC may be approached to explore the availability of space in Kidwai Nagar or, Sarojini Nagar for creation of Infrastructure of Jal Bhavan. Thereafter, the proposal of creation of Jal Bhavan building may be added in the EFC proposal of ID under processing.

- The SFC Schemes costing less than 500 crores need to be submitted to JS & FA within one week.

- There shall be detailed study under River Basin Management Scheme. Status of surplus and deficient state rivers shall be identified and shall be included in this.

- Efforts/actions shall be initiated to implement Mihir Shah Committee Report at the earliest. A presentation in this connection shall be organised in the next meeting.

- Draft Bill on River Basin Authority – A report on the status of the bill may be given in the

next meeting.

* We need to take steps to regulate extraction of Ground Water in Puri , Orrisa. - Notification in this regard may be shown to the Hon'ble Minister immediately.

- Aquifer Mapping to be done on priority basis for those areas where water is traditionally at lower level. Bundelkhand and Marathwada regions to be given top priority being most water deprived regions.

- Farakka Barrage Tourism Project may be executed through some companies/organisations who are expert in this field for creation of better tourism opportunities, which shall also create job opportunities to the local people.

[Chairman(FBP)]

- Integrated Flood Management:- River Basin wise flood presentations should be organised through Video conferencing with Chief Secretaries of the concerned States. Nodal officers of the States should also be called in the meeting. Separate detailed presentation on River Basin Systems planned in the scheme/model be given to the Hon'ble Minister (WR, RD & GR).

- DEM - Efforts shall be undertaken to explore the possibility of dissemination of info pertaining to Crisis Management/Flood Forecasting through SMS to local/prioritised area people (mobile based system). A meeting with Ministry of Communication in this regard can be organised to implement this. The complete system should be ready before onset of Monsoon. Improved DEM version incorporating all the issues raised during the meeting shall be presented in the next meeting.

- Court Cases/Contempt Cases to be reviewed by JS Level Officers in Ministry (proper)/CWC/CGWB and other organisations.

- The Court Cases from now onwards will be reviewed by JS(PP) on a regular basis.

- PMO/VIP references should be disposed off at the earliest. Pending replies by Wings/SMDs/ organisations to be submitted on priority for finalisation of pending cases.
