ORDER

Subject: Visit of two officials from the Ministry for attending Side-Events to be held at the India Pavilion during COP-23, in Bonn Germany for 06-08 November 2017 (excluding travel time).

Sanction of the competent authority is hereby accorded to the deputation of Shri B.R.K. Pillai, Commissioner (CAD) and Shri Sanjay Marwaha, Regional Director, Central Ground Water Board for attending the side events to be held at the India Pavilion for 06-08 November 2017 (excluding travel time).

2. Each of the above officers is sanctioned the following:-

- (i) **Air Passage (to and fro):** As per entitlement.
- (ii) **Daily Allowance:** US \$ 400 (@ US\$ 100 per day for 4 days) for each officer. Officers can draw the DA either in India or from Indian Mission in Germany. In case, meals are included in hotel accommodation, the DA will be given at reduced rates as per Gol guidelines.
- (iii) **Conveyance:** Internal travel is to be arranged by Indian Mission/ Embassy in Germany.
- (iv) **Hotel Accommodation:** As per entitlement, to be arranged by Indian Mission in Germany.
- (v) **Airport tax/health insurance:** As per actual.

3. The entire expenditure on the visit of above two officers above shall be charged on Budget head "Implementation of NWM scheme" FY 2017-18 under sub-head 'Foreign Tour Expenditure' (FTE) (Head of Account: 2701.80.800.18.00.12).

4. The officers shall travel on diplomatic/ official passport. The period of absence from the post in India and grant of pay and allowances and counting of services for increment of above officers will be regulated in accordance with the provisions of Para 13-15 of the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure O.M. No. 19036/7/75-E.IV (B) dated 5.8.1976.

5. The resignation or request for voluntary retirement from service while abroad will not be entertained under any circumstances. The officers will not stay abroad under any circumstances beyond the above-mentioned approved period without the prior sanction of Government of India.

6. Remuneration/honorarium/fees, if any, received by the official during the visit will be governed by SR-11 and SR-12 (FR-SR. Part-I) and Government of India Orders printed there under.

6. The officers shall submit a report about his visit to Ministry of External Affairs (Europe West Division) and Ministry of Water Resources (EA & IC Division) within one month of their return to India.
