

ORDER

Sub: Constitution of Committee under the Chairmanship of Secretary (WR, RD & GR) for completing the process of allocation of funds for Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSSs) in a time bound manner.

In a meeting to review the status of State-wise allocation of funds during 2017-18 under Central Sponsored Schemes (CSSs) (copy of the minutes attached); the CEO, NITI Aayog emphasized that the concerned Ministries/ Department must constitute the Committee under the Chairmanship of the Secretary including the concerned Financial Adviser and Nodal Adviser from NITI Aayog as members so that the process of the allocation of funds for CSSs could be completed in a time bound manner. Accordingly, it has been decided with the approval of the Competent Authority to constitute a Committee for completing the process of allocation of funds for 2 Centrally Sponsored Schemes in Ministry of Water Resources, RD & GR namely Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) and Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP) under the umbrella of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY). 

Subject: Summary Record of the discussion of the meeting held on 15th May, 2017 under the Chairmanship of Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog to review the status of scheme-wise /State-wise allocation of funds during 2017-18 under 28 Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSSs).

A meeting to review the status of scheme-wise/State-wise allocation of funds during 2017-18 under 28 Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSSs) was held under the Chairmanship of Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog at 1600 Hrs. on 15th May, 2017 in Committee Room No 122, NITI Aayog. A list of participants is at Annexure-I.

- While welcoming the participants, Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog mentioned that the objective of this meeting is to deliberate on various issues relating to effective implementation of CSSs across the States/UTs.
- The CEO, NITI Aayog informed all the participants that the 66 Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSSs) which were operational during the Twelfth Five Year Plan have now been rationalized into 28 Umbrella Schemes. Out of these 28 Umbrella Schemes, 6 Schemes have been categorized as Core of Core Schemes, 21 Schemes as Core Schemes and remaining one as Optional Scheme.
- The CEO, NITI further stated that classification and share of Central Government for the Border Area Development Programme (BADP) has been decided by the Finance Minister in consultation with the Ministry of Home Affairs and NITI Aayog. He further stated that the concerned Ministries have to be serious on this issue, as the same was critical as approved by the Cabinet.
- The Vice Chairman stated that in view of the problems faced by the states, the funds must be managed well through Time Management and insisted for transit from expenditure based monitoring to outcomes based monitoring.
- Thereafter each participant from the Central Ministries/ Departments presented their views regarding implementation of various CSSs and discussed in brief about how they are going ahead in allocation of budget for the Centrally Sponsored Schemes. The various issues were deliberated at length and finally taken into account the views of Ministries/ Departments, Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog directed to ensure better management of resources for the CSSs.

- The CEO, NITI emphasized that the concerned Ministries/ Departments must constitute the Committee under the chairmanship of the Secretary of the Administrative Ministry/ Department, including the concerned Financial Advisor and nodal Adviser from NITI Aayog as Members so that the process of allocation of funds for CSSs could be completed in a time bound manner. NITI Aayog may be informed on the action taken in this regard. If any such Committee comprising the Financial Adviser of the Ministry under Chairpersonship of the Secretary is already in place, then the concerned Adviser from NITI Aayog may be co-opted as a member, in pursuance of the Cabinet order for rationalization of CSSs.
- Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog also mentioned that the flexi-funds available in each CSS has been raised from the current level of 10 per cent to 25 per cent for the States and 30 per cent for the UTs of the overall annual allocation under each Scheme so that the implementation can be better attuned to the needs of individual State /UT.
- Advisor (Admn./FR) made a presentation on 'Social Sector expenditure of States for the year 2014-15 (Pre Fourteenth Finance Commission) & 2015-16 (Post Fourteenth Finance Commission)' and highlighted that there has been positive response by the State Government to greater untied fund, States have been allocating funds according to their priorities and Social Sector Expenditure has increased over previous year.

The meeting was ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
